



While sleeping I visit the places I long for on the astral plane, often seeing ripples of memories or moments overlapping into one.




Vicky Helms The Enigmatic Traveler Paper Collage




















Elaine Piechowski Beloved acrylic, acetate, liquid glass 48" x 60"



So much has been going on in our lives at this time and a lot of it is negative. Let the good stuff come.




Karol Blumenthal Longing for Nature Mixed Media Collage

While you are at home trying to amuse yourself (and others), here's something to consider for later this historic year -- a CAA Board Position, such as:


Program Chairman: manage and find a speaker for only four General Meetings a year.









Speaking of social distancing, **Kwei-lin Lum** has made various computer graphics during her sequestration. Here is a public service art chart, "How Long is Six Feet?"






HOW LONG IS 6 FEET?


